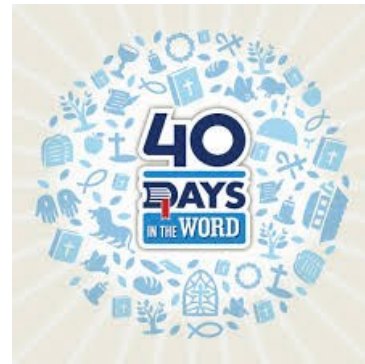
### OUTSIDE OUR DOOR

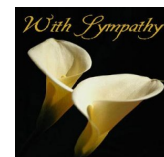
