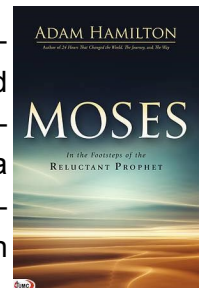
## TALLY BREAKFAST

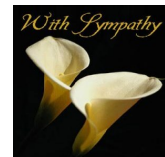
